



## S4.1 Your Slide Show

### What should your slide show include?

Your electronic slide show will need to include an explanation of how you approached each step of the process and what you discovered. It should provide the judges and others who don't know your school grounds with a clear impression of your site as it is NOW, and an understanding of what design changes you would like to see happen - both on a broad, whole-site scale and a more focused scale.

#### Step 1 - Getting Started

How did you get started, launch Grounds for Optimism and form your leadership team?

How were other people involved?

How was the vision statement prepared?  
What was the vision?

#### Step 2 - People & Place NOW

What was discovered about the site and each of the spaces within it? How are the spaces used? What do they feel like? What are the good and bad things about them?

#### Step 3 - People & Place FUTURE

Exploring options for the whole site:

What future arrangements and relationships between spaces did you look at?

How did your findings in step 2 affect this?

Thinking about *Your space, your way*:

- Describe the space or theme that was chosen as the focus.
- How did your findings help you reach this decision?
- Explain why this choice was made and clearly show/explain your design ideas and concepts for change.
